

TASK FORCE

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The Task Force is comprised of up to 12 people (with one who serves as Chairman) who are vitally interested in the Crusade's success. The Task Force will select all of the Crusade Leadership which consists of the Executive Team and Crusade Team Chairmen. The individuals selected will be the keys to the success of the entire Crusade. Many times those who serve on the Task Force also will be the best individuals to serve on the Executive Team or serve as a chairman on another Crusade Team because of their concern and vision for the Crusade.

WHAT DOES THE TASK FORCE DO?

Selects Crusade Leadership

The individuals selected will be the key to the success of the entire Crusade. The Task Force will work together to fill each leadership position (see the Crusade Organizational Chart).

- Leadership Selection Process:
 - Pray for God's wisdom and guidance in selecting those individuals who will best serve as the Crusade Leadership.
 - Strive to select individuals with strong Christian character and place them in positions which use their spiritual gifts and natural talents.
 - Provide a copy of the applicable committee section from the Crusade Manual to each individual who is asked to serve.
 - Ensure those asked to serve have a clear understanding of their responsibilities and the commitment necessary before making their decision.
 - Selection of all leadership positions should be completed within 30 days.

Selects Crusade Date

- Select a Crusade date. Make sure there are no conflicts with community or church events such as revivals, conferences, fairs, holidays, proms, ball games, etc.

- Make sure the date is available with GO TELL Crusades. Once the date has been determined, GO TELL will develop a tentative schedule of events leading up to the Crusade.

Selects Crusade Location/Venue

- Typically, Crusades are held on the home side of a local high school football stadium. GO TELL will help in the selection process to make certain of the suitability.
- Determine an indoor alternative venue (if applicable) in the event of inclement weather.

Selects Crusade Name

- Choose a name that includes the area you are trying to reach but is short enough to be used in publicity material, i.e., Mid-America GO TELL Crusade or Southeast Georgia GO TELL Crusade. GO TELL should be a part of the name of the Crusade.

Begins Church Mobilization

Each member of the Task Force should begin contacting other churches in their area to cast the Crusade vision and encourage them to become involved.

- **Plans Crusade Information Seminars** – conducted by GO TELL staff to inform pastors and lay leaders of the Crusade process and answer any questions.
- These seminars will be breakfast, lunch and dinner meetings over two or three days with a video and Power Point presentation shown. (Please be certain the locations selected will have the means to show the media presentation.)
