

## **Tomorrow's Hope GO TELL Crusade in Jena, LA**

The Tomorrow's Hope GO TELL Crusade in Jena/LaSalle Parish, Louisiana was used to give eternal hope Sept. 23-26 as 233 people made commitments to the Lord Jesus Christ.

Evangelist Rick Gage, with GO TELL Ministries of Atlanta, led the crusade with assistance from team evangelist Scott Camp and many in the community who were involved in praying and planning over several months.

During the crusade week, more than 2,500 attended the four-night outreach at the Jena High School Gymnasium.

Nearly 1,300 students were reached through GO TELL's nationally acclaimed ON TRACK Assembly program.

Crusade Chairman Wayne Davis said, "We had 109 salvation decisions. A large number were young people. A good number of their parents were not there. They brought their children and dropped them off. We have a tremendous opportunity to reach these parents.

"As an example, there was a young man who came to repent and 'get his life back on track.' He said, 'Now I need to get my parents to get their life straightened out.'

"Then there was the dad who had not long been out of rehab, and he learned of the crusade and drove 35 miles to bring his adult son with him to be reconciled. The son repented, forgave his father and got his life right with God. Now he was going to go talk with his sister," Davis recalled.

"While we praise God for those who accepted Jesus, there were many times more who were asking for prayers for their family members who needed salvation and reconciliation. We have only begun. With God's help, there are many more who our churches need to reach for Jesus."
